POSITION SUMMARY:

Provide direction for the students and implements program curriculum. Provide a quality experience for children and parents that focus on the YMCA values: honesty, respect, responsibility, and caring.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- **1.** Work with Lead teacher to provide a nurturing environment that supports learning and encourages independence and decision making.
- **2.** Engage in Conscious Disipline Practices to support a child's ability to acquire the skills of self-discipline.
- **3.** Supervises the students, classroom, and all activities and make ongoing, systematic observations and evaluations of each child.
- **4.** Work effectively with other Y employees.
- **5.** Accepts and demonstrates the Y's values. Demonstrates a desire to serve others and fulfill community needs.
- **6.** Builds effective, supportive working relationships with team memebers.
- 7. Attend all required meetings, trainings and professional development opportunities as directed.
